

**Pooling Agreement for Equitable Title I Services between**

Whereas, both Nonpublic School A and Nonpublic School B seek to provide equitable services to eligible children attending private schools within their respective groups, in accordance with Title I of the Elementary and Secondary Education Act (ESEA) as amended by the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA);

The Jackson Township School District (JSD), in consultation with appropriate private school officials, shall establish criteria to determine the eligible private school students in greatest educational need to receive services;

The services provided to eligible children attending a particular private school shall not be contingent upon the amount of funds generated by children from low-income families in that school, but shall be based solely on educational need;

Should private school officials representing different groups of private schools request pooling, the JSD may establish a separate pool for each requesting group;

Now, therefore, in consideration of the mutual covenants and agreements contained herein, the parties hereby agree as follows:

1. Pooling of Title I Funds: Nonpublic School A and Nonpublic School B agree use one vendor for student services to pool the Title I funds generated by children from low-income families who reside in participating Title I public school attendance areas and attend a private school within their respective groups.

2. Establishment of Criteria: The JSD, in consultation with appropriate private school officials, shall establish criteria to determine the eligible private school students in greatest educational need to receive services. These criteria shall be fair, transparent, and based on educational need.
3. Equitable Provision of Services: The services provided to eligible children attending a particular private school shall be based solely on educational need, irrespective of the amount of funds generated by children from low-income families in that school.
4. Compliance: Both parties agree to comply with all applicable federal, state, and local laws and regulations governing the provision of Title I services to eligible children attending private schools.
5. Term: This Agreement shall commence on the date first written above and shall continue until the end of the school year.
6. Amendment: This Agreement may not be amended or modified during the school year
